July 9, 2008

Chicken Enchiladas

1 can each of cream of mushroom and chicken soup

Small can green chili and sliced olives

Small sour cream (8 Oz.)

2-3 chicken breasts cooked & shredded

Flour tortillas & ½ cup shredded cheese

**Mix soups, sour cream and chilies together; divide in ½; in one ½ add shredded chicken & ½ olives
In 9 x 13 pan cover bottom with soup mixture; stuff chicken mix in tortillas roll and lay in pan
Pour remaining soup mixture over top and top with olives and shredded cheese; cover lightly
Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes**

**Directions to Carousel Ranch:
Take Sierra Highway, west; just past
Agua Dulce Canyon Road, turn up Mint
Canyon; Turn right on Rocking Horse Rd;
Drive down dirt road until you get there.**
